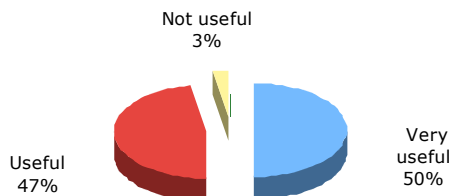

2008 NEM Summit - Post-event survey results

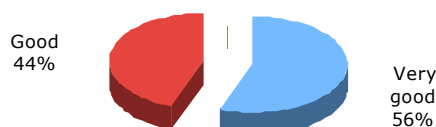
Number of surveyed people: 368 (out of 402 participants) / Number of received answers: 72 (19,6%)

How do you assess your overall participation in the event?



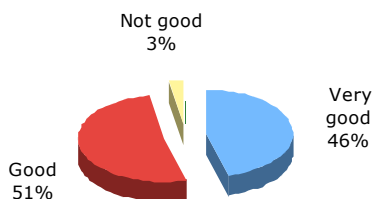
A large majority of participants have found the event very useful or useful. Only a small minority (3%) has not found the event useful.

How do you assess the overall quality of the exhibition?



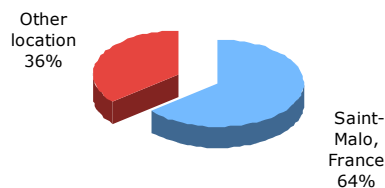
100% of the participants have rated the exhibition at least "good", or "very good". The exhibition is considered as a strong asset of the event. Some comments from the participants were to leave more time between the conference sessions for visiting the exhibition.

How do you assess the networking opportunities provided by the event?



The assessment of the networking opportunities provided by the event is very good. The gala dinner, the lunches and coffee breaks in the exhibition area have been very much appreciated.

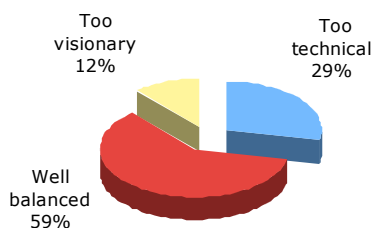
What location would you recommend for the 2009 NEM Summit?



Most participants recommend organising the 2009 NEM Summit in Saint-Malo, a location appreciated for its size, enabling to strengthen networking opportunities.

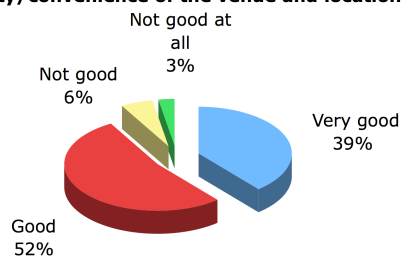
However, accessibility is an issue. Despite the shuttles to and from the venue, several participants recommend to organise the 2009 NEM Summit closer to an international airport.

How do you assess the overall quality of the conference program?



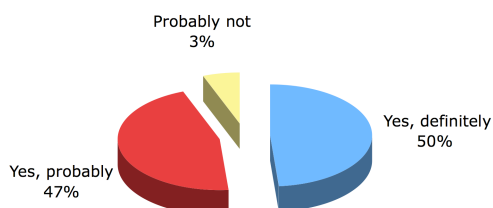
The overall assessment of the conference program is good. However, some negative comments related to the quality of the ppt presentations (which have not been approved by the TPC).

How do you assess the overall quality/convenience of the venue and location?



Overall rating is good. 9% of the respondents have however found the quality of the venue and location not satisfying (mainly for accessibility issues).
